<i>Fresh, floral, complex. Red berries, cherries, cut flowers &amp; licorice linger over ripe tannins.</i>

<i>Ripe dark fruits &amp; cherry accented with traces of wet stone &amp; smoky spice. Structured yet smooth.</i>

A current selection of natural, organic & biodynamic wines

At Cru, we have always been passionate about small-production, artisanal wineries & grape growers. We feel it is important to highlight a movement among these passionate farmers & winemakers that focuses attention on how grape farming impacts the land. This trend of “Natural Wines” is still forming its definition; natural wines aim for a more pure expression by pursuing a ‘less is more’ approach in the vineyard & in the cellar. They encompass the categories of organic and biodynamic wine. Importantly, this does not mean they are better than conventional wines...just another take on how to make grape juice that we enjoy drinking. Here are some examples we are excited about!

### **Definitions:**

**Natural:** No additives, organic and/or biodynamic farming, no fining/filtration, only indigenous yeasts. (N)

**Organic:** grapes grown without chemicals, limited or no sulfur depending on region. (O)

**Biodynamic:** ritualistic principals of farming without chemicals and in coordination with the phases of the moon, along with a close relationship to the land as a whole. (B)
