<i>Un-oaked & bright. Red & black cherries, currants, dried herbs, chalky tannins, high acid.</i>	
PINOT NOIR Bishop's Peak San Luis Obispo, California 2015	15/60
<i>Sweet red berries & fresh-cut flowers with a slight mineral edge. Supple, ripe tannins.</i>	
GRENACHE Lafage 'Nicolas' Cotes Catalanes, France	10/40
<i>Soft & supple. Blackberry, cherry pit, anise, faintest hint of cracked pepper. Lithe & focused.</i>	
CARIGNAN BLEND 2 Ânes 'Fontanilles' Corbieres, France 2013	13/52
<i>'Natural' wine at its best—dark blue & red fruits, dried herbs & cocoa. Screams south of France.</i>	
SYRAH Donkey & Goat El Dorado, California 2013	16/64

A current selection of natural, organic & biodynamic wines

At Cru, we have always been passionate about small-production, artisanal wineries & grape growers. We feel it is important to highlight a movement among these passionate farmers & winemakers that focuses attention on how grape farming impacts the land. This trend of “Natural Wines” is still forming its definition; natural wines aim for a more pure expression by pursuing a ‘less is more’ approach in the vineyard & in the cellar. They encompass the categories of organic and biodynamic wine. Importantly, this does not mean they are better than conventional wines...just another take on how to make grape juice that we enjoy drinking. Here are some examples we are excited about!

Definitions:

Natural: No additives, organic and/or biodynamic farming, no fining/filtration, only indigenous yeasts. (N)

Organic: grapes grown without chemicals, limited or no sulfur depending on region. (O)

Biodynamic: ritualistic principals of farming without chemicals and in coordination with the phases of the moon, along with a close relationship to the land as a whole. (B)
